On May 20, 2021, the Board entered an Order imposing a monetary penalty on the Petitioner in the amount of Two Million Four Hundred Ninety-Six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,496,250.00) with all but Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) being held in abeyance. The Petitioner requests that the May 20, 2021 Board Order be amended to place a time limitation on the amount held in abeyance and/or reduce the amount of monetary penalty held in abeyance.

#### ACTION OF THE BOARD

Based upon the clear and convincing evidence presented at the petition hearing, the Board voted to amend the May 20, 2021 Order to discharge the monetary penalty held in abeyance ten (10) years from the date of the original Order. The monetary penalty held in abeyance shall hereby be discharged on May 20, 2031. All other provisions of the May 20, 2021 Board Order shall remain unchanged.
