

MISSISSIPPI BOARD OF PHARMACY

JULY 2018 BOARD MEETING OVERVIEW



The Mississippi Board of Pharmacy met on July 19, 2018 to conduct business and hold disciplinary hearings. The following is a synopsis of some of the items presented or considered by the Board during their meeting:

- The Board recognized Todd Barrett with a plaque for his dedicated service as President of the Board for the last year.
- Robert Dozier, Executive Director of the Mississippi Independent Pharmacists Association (MIPA) informed the Board of the many activities ongoing with MIPA including the annual convention and district meetings and the ongoing efforts with the Mississippi Congressional Delegation regarding DIR fees.
- Denise DeRossette provided a budget update to the Board.
- The Board was informed about grant money that is being used for a billboard media campaign addressing the opioid crisis.
- The PMP division reported about the launching of the Mississippi PMP specific website.
- The Licensing division gave a report on the upcoming renewal period for multiple permits, licenses and registrations.
- The Compliance division reported that 825 inspections were performed over the last year to include wholesaler inspections and 795 and 797 compounding inspections.
