CONCLUSION OF CONSENT AGENDA

The Dr. Thomas Dobbs from the Mississippi Department of Health provided a presentation on the Medical Marijuana Initiative/Referendum that will be on the ballot for the November 2020 election.

Todd Barrett made a motion to go into executive session for the purpose of discussing potential litigation concerning the issue of medical marijuana. Guy Phillips seconded the motion and the motion was approved without objection.

Todd Barrett made a motion to re-enter open session and the motion was seconded by Guy Phillips Farmer. The motion passed without objection. The Board reported that no action was taken during the executive session.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

The Board provided special recognition to several agents from the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics for their continued assistance and cooperation with the compliance division when handling diversion and burglary cases.

Susan McCoy, Executive Director, reported to the Board that staff had attended State Personnel Board training on Employee Performance Review Evaluations. A contract for a new licensing system has been signed and we will begin the process of developing it soon. The Licensing division reported that year-end renewals for pharmacist licenses, drug facility permits and pharmacy permits had closed out. The renewal portal for pharmacy technicians has been opened for the March 31 renewal deadline. PMP is continuing to educate stakeholders on the use of the PMP system. Compliance is continuing to review compounding certificate applications.

Jerry Fortenberry with the Mississippi Association of Recovering Pharmacists (MARF) reported that there will be a MARF Conference in Hattiesburg in March.
