PHARMACISTS IN CHARGE TOP COMPLIANCE ISSUES

Commonly observed compliance violations seen during inspections for you to be aware of. Be aware, Be compliant!

1

Unlicensed personnel or staff with expired license/registration.

2

Employment location not updated with the Board of Pharmacy (pharmacists and techs).

3

Not printing the controlled substance printouts regulary.

(at least every 7 days)

1

Not separating Schedule II medications from Schedule III-V medications on the annual controlled substance inventory and filing separately...one file for CII's and a separate file for III-V

5

Not including whether the annual inventory was done at open or close of business.

6

Transfer/borrowing medication between pharmacies not done properly (by invoice)

7

Using the wrong prescriber DEA number

8

Expired medications in active inventory: Check your inventory regularly for outdated and/ or expired medications.

9

Pharmacist-Tech ratio not followed; not understanding tasks that differentiate cashiers from pharmacy technicians

10

Pharmacy technicians "stealing time" or customer coupons for personal use (both considered theft)

11

Termination of employees without notifying the board

12

Too many medications not used and not returned to stock appropriately
